Use new cassette, pipette and lancet for each patient.

NB: All positive results must be confirmed with further laboratory tests.


Read instructions before use.

Check expiry date on the foil pouch. Do not use if expired.


Clean the finger puncture site with the alcohol swab, allow to dry.



4 Twist to remove protective cap from the safety lancet.



**5** Push the open end of the lancet firmly against the finger to active.




Add the collected blood to the

10 Read results AT 15 minutes. Reading results too early or too late can give false results.



1 Results:

Negative -A C-line forms but there is no T1 or T2-line.

Positive -The T1 or T2 forms together with a C-line.



## Invalid -

When the C-line does not form, the test must be repeated with a new device.
